

BEAT CANCER, ATTEND YOUR SCREENING

Screening programmes can help to diagnose cancer or risk of cancer earlier improving the likelihood of successful treatment. There are three national cancer screening programmes in England.

• **Cervical screening** - offered to people with a cervix. Routine screening is offered every three years up to 49 years of age and every five years from 50 to 64 years of age. You will be sent an invitation to book an appointment when you are due.

• **Breast screening** - offered to women aged 50 to their 71st birthday in England. You'll first be invited for screening within three years of your 50th birthday and will receive further invites until you are 71.

• **Bowel screening** – offered to men and women aged 60-74 every two years. You'll be sent a home testing kit to collect a small sample of poo that checks for tiny amounts of blood which could be caused by cancer.

Screening can detect a problem even before you have symptoms. Early diagnosis can mean that treatment is more effective.



If you are eligible to be screened, please have your test and let's beat cancer.

WHAT IS AN NHS HEALTH CHECK?

The NHS Health Check is a free check-up with a Healthcare Assistant for people who are aged 40 to 74, without certain existing medical conditions, that assesses your overall health.

It can tell you whether you're at higher risk of getting certain health problems and allow early intervention for any previously undiagnosed conditions. If you are eligible you will be invited to attend every 5 years.

COVID Boosters are currently available for all immunosuppressed patients or patients over the age of 75.

There are clinics running throughout May at Bosmere and at Oaks Healthcare in Cowplain, PO8 8DL. If you have received an invite to book your appointment, please do this by calling 119 or visiting the link displayed in your invite message.

If you have not received an invite it is likely you do not meet the eligibility criteria on this occasion even if you may have been eligible for previous booster campaigns.

Please note that these clinics are not run by Bosmere, so unfortunately, we are unable to book this appointment for you or able to advise when you will receive your invitation.



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

PRESCRIPTION REMINDER

When requesting a repeat of your prescription, please bear in mind that unfortunately we cannot take any requests over the telephone. Requests can be submitted through the Practice website, your



Patient Access account, the NHS App or by using the request form available at the Reception Desk. This allows us to keep a sufficient audit trail of all requests coming through the Practice and makes tracking your request easier.

Requests can be submitted up to 9 days before your new prescription is due, but please allow 2 working days to process.

DNA's (Did Not Attend)

Did you know each time an appointment is not attended, it costs the NHS a minimum of £60 per doctor's appointment



and approximately £30 for a nurse appointment.
